The fonts used for *Voices Together* are Palatino, Optima, and Scriptina.


The colors used for *Voices Together* are purple and gold.

Pantone: 618 Process: C 35, M 30, Y 96, K 3 R 173, G 158, B 61






Logotype

The title artwork will serve as the logotype for *Voices Together*.

The logotype should not be distorted in any way. Make certain when resizing that the dimensions are constrained. Word does this by default when resizing graphics but other programs may require one to hold down the Control key, or another key, to maintain the correct ratio as it is resized.

The words should not be separated.

The fonts should not be switched between the words.











The recommended colors for reproducing the logotype are black, white, purple, or gold.

Symbol

The dove symbol serves as complimenting graphic for *Voices Together*.

The dove symbol should not be distorted in any way. The same care is required in handling/resizing the symbol as is given for the logotype.

The symbol should not be reversed or rotated.

The recommended colors for reproducing the symbol are black, white, purple, gold, or any percent tone thereof.



Combination

The title/logotype and dove symbol combination serves as the complete graphic identity for *Voices Together*.

This combination should not be distorted in any way. The same care is required in handling/resizing the combination as is given for the logotype alone and for the symbol alone.

The combination should be kept in the respective size and location relationship as shown at right, top.

An exception to the above arrangement is to use the dove symbol as a background graphic behind the logotype or other text, as shown below and in the ad, below right. In this application, the dove should be reproduced in a tone of black, purple, or gold.
